Treasurer: The person assuming the Treasurer's position does NOT need to be an accountant but some experience with budgets and bookkeeping would be in order. The person needs to be someone who enjoys detailed work and who has computer skills. Currently Excel is being used, but there is talk of changing over to a software program such as Quicken, so familiarity with these programs would be necessary.

- Manage all incoming and outgoing funds for the SCA Women's Club.
- Prepare monthly budget reports and submit to the SCAWC Board and village coordinators.
- Prepare end of year budget report for submission to the SCA Association.
- Create the following year's budget forecast.

Communications Director: This position requires knowledge of Microsoft Office including Word, Power Point, and Publisher.

The Communications Director will work with a designated photographer and include pertinent pictures in the club newsletter and power point presentations.

Duties include the following:

- Prepare the monthly club article for the community magazine, The Spirit and send to the editor.
- Prepare the monthly club newsletter, The Chatter and send to the webmaster for the club web site.
- Prepare the power point presentation for monthly club luncheons which include current activities for both the club and the villages.
- Prepare Women's Club Membership Application updating seasonally as needed.
- Prepare Women's Club Handbook annually.
- Additional activities may include signs, Chatter Special Editions and other printed media to support committees.

The luncheon will be held in the Anthem Center with cash prizes. The menu will be a boxed lunch. Beverage service is also included. More lunch details in the September Chatter

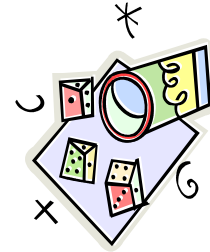
